RESOLUTION 2022-C

A RESOLUTION TO ELECT THE STANDARD ALLOWANCE AVAILABLE UNDER THE REVENUE LOSS PROVISION OF THE CORONAVIRUS LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUN EXTABLISHED UNDER THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Congress adopted the American Rescue Plan Act in March 2021 ("ARPA") which included \$65 tillion in recovery funds for cities across the country; and

WHEREAS, ARPA funds are intended to provide support to state, local, and tribal governments in responding to the impact of COVID-19 in their communities, residents, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, The Fiscal Recovery Funds provides for \$19,.53 billion in payments to be made to States and territories which will distribute the funds to non-entitlement units of local government (NEU); and

WHEREAS, The ARPA requires that States and territories allocate funding to NEUs in an amount that bears the same proportion as the population of the NEU bears to the total population of all NEUs in the State or territory; and

WHEREAS, \$61,593.62 (sixty-one thousand five hundred and ninety-three dollars and sixty-two cents).

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds ensures that governments have the resources needed to fight the pandemic and support families and businesses struggling with its public realth and economic impacts maintain vital public services, even amid declines in revenue, and build a strong, resilient, and equitable recovery by making investments that support long-term growth and apportunity; and

WHEREAS, In May 2021, the US Department of Treasury ("Treasury") published the Interim Final Rule escribing eligible and ineligible uses of funds as well as other program provisions, sought feedback from the public on these program rules, and began to distribute funds; and

WHEREAS, on January 6, 2022, Treasury issued the final rule. The final rule delivers broader flexibility and greater simplicity in the program, responsive to feedback in the comment process; and

WHEREAS, the final rule offers a standard allowance for revenue loss of up to \$10 million, allowing recipients to select between a standard amount of revenue loss or complete a full revenue loss calculation; and

WHEREAS, recipients that select the standard allowance may use that amount, in many cases their full award, for government services, with streamlined reporting requirements; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Arcadia, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Village of Arcadia elects to use The Standard Allowance available under the revenue loss provision of the American Rescue Plan in the amount of \$61,593.62 (sixty-one thousand five hundred and ninety-three dollars and sixty-two cents) to be used for the general provision of government services.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all deliberations and actions of Council concerning and related to the passage of this Resolution were held in meeting open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservations of the public peace, health, and safety of the inhabitants of the Village and is immediately necessary for the proper function of Village government, and therefore this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
