## **RESOLUTION 2024-B**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO UTILIZE ARPA FUNDS AS PART OF THE FINAL RULE OF LOST REVENUE STANDARD ALLOWANCE FOR A MASTER METER AT THE WATER PUMP STATION.

WHEREAS, On May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023 the Village Administrator notified the Village council that the City of Fostoria is requesting that the Village install a new master meter at the water pump station located on the corner of State Route 12 and County Road 330; and

WHEREAS, Fostoria has notified the administrator that the master meter is difficult to read and they have requested to have the meter replaced; and

WHEREAS, the Administrator has received a quote from NECO, the bid amount amounts to \$8,681.00 (eight thousand six hundred and eighty-one dollars) to replace and install the new master meter, the Village Council finds said bid to be reasonable; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of the project the cost exceeds the original quote, additional work including, six-inch flanges, installation fees, and a signalizer; and

WHEREAS, the addition quote will increase the cost \$2,649.78 (two-thousand six hundred forty-nine dollars and seventy-eight dollars); and

WHEREAS, the administrator has received an updated quote of \$11,330.78 (eleventhousand three hundred thirty-three dollars and seventy-eight dollars) to replace and install the new master meter, the Village Council finds said bid to be reasonable; and

WHEREAS, in January of 2022 the Department of Treasury released the completed Interim Final Rule titled SLFRF Final Rule (Final Rule), establishing the completed guidance for SLFRF; and

WHEREAS, the Final Rule indicates that the Treasury allows lost revenue replacement to be calculated through a formula as provided by the Treasury, or by a \$10,000,000.00 standard allowance, and

WHEREAS, the Village Council seeks to pay for government services with funds out of the lost revenue replacement; and

NOW THEREFFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Arcadia, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Village Administrator be authorized and directed to contract with Fostoria Water and Sewer for \$11,330.78 (eleven-thousand three hundred thirty-three dollars and seventy-eight dollars) to replace and install the new master at the water pump station.

Section 2: That the Village will use ARPA funds to pay for the provision of government services in 2024 as part of the lost revenue replacement.
