Arcadia Village Council Meeting Minutes, January 17th, 2022

Arcadia Village Council met for regular rescheduled session on January 17th, 2022 at the Town Hall located at 104 South Gibson Street Arcadia, Ohio. At 7:00 p.m. Mayor Chester Balderson called the meeting to order. All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

It was determined that the seats that needed to be filled would be tabled for the next meeting. Mayor Balderson asked if any residents were interested in the seats. Three residents Angela Kimble, Vicki Simon and Rachele Harmon stated that they were interested in the open council seats. Under the circumstances the council did not have enough members present to have a quorum and the meeting was canceled.


